- **Innovation** – The nominee regularly presents new ideas and helps bring them to fruition in areas such as productivity improvement, safety, workflow, efficiency, and profitability.
- **Teamwork** – The nominee consistently assists and works with fellow employees without having to be asked; eagerly participates in group or team projects; and thinks of others and the needs of the enterprise before thinking of self.
- **Leadership** – The nominee serves as a positive role model for other employees, demonstrating high integrity, ethical behavior, exceptional work habits, a strong work ethic and strong character that influence his or her fellow employees.
- **Community Service** – The nominee volunteers his/her time and/or other resources to give something back to the community, regularly engaging in some form of “giving back” to the community such as volunteerism, coaching, local government, schools, civic activities or other forms of altruism.
